Student Accessibility Services Getting the Accommodations You Need When Abroad

Register with Student Accessibility Services (SAS)

You may already be registered with SAS for academic accommodations. If not, you must register with SAS in order to receive accommodations. You can do this by visiting the [Forms](#) tab on their website and complete an application. You will also be required to supply your disability documentation before your application can be reviewed. Once registered, you will be assigned a coordinator.

Request a SAS Verification Letter be sent to the Education Abroad Advisor

Schedule a meeting with your SAS coordinator to discuss your plans of studying abroad, and request a SAS Verification Letter to be sent to the EAO regarding your unique circumstances and the accommodations you may need.

Meet with the Education Abroad Advisor, Program Leader and SAS
